

## Six Soldiers Killed in Crossing Crash

Enid, Okla. —(U.P.)— Six enlisted army men were killed early this morning when a Rock Island freight train hit the bus in which they were riding. Twenty-six other persons were injured in the accident, which occurred near Enid, Okla. The crash is believed to have resulted from poor visibility.

Army authorities identified the dead as Private Eugene Underwood of Rogersville; Sergeant Eugene Sanders of Yoakum, Texas; Private Vernon Ohnstad of Georgetown, Minn.; Sergeant Robert Walker of Bay City, Texas; Private Cyril Minarcik of Chicago; and Private Herbert Taylor of Lake Kerr, Fla.

Of the 26 injured persons, 13 were sent to hospitals and two are not expected to live. Those in most serious condition are Private John Ludlun of Battle Creek, Mich.; and First Sergeant George Showalter.

Army authorities report that the men were returning to the army air corps flying school base at Enid at the time of the accident. They were riding in an Enid transportation bus.
